At UCLA, Savage has established the Bruins as a national championship contender, leading the Bruins to its first appearance in the College World Series in 2010.

Aside from making strides on the field, Savage has found success on the recruiting trail. Each of his recruiting classes have been nationally ranked in the top-20 by Baseball America.

Additionally, Savage's players at UCLA have seen success in the Major League Draft and in professional baseball. UCLA has produced 42 draft selections, including a program-record-tying 12 draft picks in 2006. Three of Savage's pitchers at UCLA, left-hander David Huff (Cleveland), and right-handers Josh Roenicke (Toronto) and Hector Ambriz (Cleveland) have been promoted to the major leagues. Of those 42 selections, 14 have been chosen within the draft's first 10 rounds.
